


EXCITING LAND RELEASE IN TOM PRICE



The Shire of Ashburton is pleased to announce the release of residential and industrial land to the public in the thriving town of Tom Price.


6 industrial lots and 13 residential lots will be offered for auction on 19 February 2011, with a further 24 residential lots going under the hammer on 19 March 2011.

A Roadshow will also be held in Tom Price on 22 January 2011, allowing builders, finance providers and other related services the opportunity to showcase their products to prospective purchasers.


STAGE 1 – Auction Saturday 19th February 2011


Warara Street – 13 Residential Lots
