## Shire of Ashburton Local Government Heritage Inventory Nomination Form

The Shire of Ashburton has recently commenced a review of its Municipal Heritage Inventory. As part of this process the Shire is seeking nominations from the community to identify places that aren't already identified for potential listing on the Shire's Municipal Heritage Inventory.

If you are aware of a place that might be of local significance we encourage you to complete and submit this nomination form by **Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> October 2016**.

What does inclusion in Municipal Heritage Inventory mean?

Under the *Heritage of Western Australia Act 1990* the Shire is required to compile and maintain an inventory of buildings of cultural heritage significance. The inventory is an information source of places of local heritage value, however inclusion on a Municipal Heritage Inventory has no statutory implications/protection.

For a local government to have statutory authority and influence to manage the development of a heritage place, a place needs to be identified within the Heritage List adopted under a Local Planning Scheme. As part of this project the Shire will also be considering which places should be included on the Heritage List.

The information you provide in the nomination will help the Shire and its consultants decide if a place should be assessed further or if it is likely to be of local heritage value. The Shire undertakes to keep all personal details regarding you (the referring party) confidential and will not release any personal details to any person, except to the extent required by law or with the consent of the referring party.

What are the criteria for registration?

A place or area will be of significance to the locality if, in the opinion of the local government, it displays one or more of the values: Aesthetic, Historic, Research, or Social value. It is strongly recommended that nominators read the State Heritage Office's publication *Criteria for the Assessment of Local Heritage Places and Area* available at:
