Paraburdoo Community Hub on track

The new multipurpose centre will accommodate a broad range of recreation, oval and community activities as well as upgrading the aged pool facilities. The Community Hub will include repurposing the existing Sports Pavilion to accommodate the Karingal Neighbourhood Centre and improve facilities for the existing user groups.

Hodge Collard Preston was awarded the Architectural services tender in January 2017 and have worked through the existing concept designs as well as the feedback provided from the project reference group to develop schematic designs of the new facilities.

The designs can be viewed on the Shire of Ashburton website or a display that has been setup in the Town Revitalisation Office located at the rear of the Ashburton Hall. The Shire of Ashburton has increased its contribution to \$4.7 million to ensure that the full scope and intended outcomes of the facility can be achieved as outlined in the initial concept design.

This project is supported by the State Government's Royalties for Regions Pilbara Cities initiative administered by the Pilbara Development Commission, Rio Tinto and Shire of Ashburton.
